LONG TERM CHICKEN SECTOR PRICING TIMELINE UPDATE

Thank you for your joint March 5, 2021 update on the BC Chicken Marketing Board (Chicken Board) and BC Broiler Hatching Egg Commission's (Commission) processes and timelines for reaching a set of pricing recommendations for consideration by the BC Farm Industry Review Board (BCFIRB).

Based on the timeline update, we understand that your final pricing recommendations will be submitted to the BCFIRB supervisory panel by April 30. 2021. The panel notes the goal of having the new BC pricing framework approved by BCFIRB and in place for period A-170 (June 6, 2021). While we will work diligently to review the recommendations we cannot commit to a decision before June 6, 2021. Timing of any panel decision(s) will, in part, depend on when the recommendations are received, the quality and comprehensiveness of the boards' processes, the SAFETI-based sound marketing policy analysis and rationale for the final recommendations.

We are aware that the Primary Poultry Processors' Association of BC requested the Chicken Board to establish a new temporary pricing formula for A-169 so that stakeholders could "...assess recent changes in ON COPF and potential impact to the industry". We are also aware of the importance of the recently amended Ontario Cost of Production Formula Regulation to the current long-term pricing structure discussions. We remind all parties that any change in current pricing structures requires the panel's prior approval pursuant to our July 3, 2020 interim pricing decision.¹ We also strongly encourage parties to continue focussing on the strategic goal of a long-term BC pricing structure for the benefit and stability of the full supply chain.
