Water Protection & Sustainability Branch Environmental Sustainability and Strategic Policy Division BC Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy The Water Protection and Sustainability Branch rescinds the 2003 B.C. interim Diisopropanolamine (DIPA) water quality guideline (WQGs) for the protection of drinking water sources of 21 mg/L (B.C. Ministry of Water, Land and Air Protection, 2003). The source drinking WQG value of 3.5 mg/L (ENV, 2020) now applies to the Ambient Water Quality Guidelines for Diisopropanolamine (DIPA): Technical Appendix (B.C. Ministry of Water, Land and Air Protection, 2003).
