
Amendment No. 6 to the Provincial Logging Residue and Waste Measurement Procedures Manual — Coast Version, Section 7.4.1.2 requires the **Advertised Date** for BCTS Timber Sales Licences (TSLs). Detailed instructions for finding that date in the BC Bid Portal are shown below. Note: in the BC Bid Portal, the term "issued date" means the date in which the BCTS TSL advertisement first appeared (posted) on the BC Bid Portal. The term "issued date" in BC Bid Portal is not the same as the legal issued date for the BCTS TSL.

- Step 1: Go to the BC Bid Public Portal: https://bcbid.gov.bc.ca/
- **Step 2:** Click on the "Find an opportunity" link in the "BC Bid Procurement Marketplace" section in the top-left corner of the page.



- Step 3: Click the I am not a Robot check box in the Security Check section near the top of the screen.
- **Step 4:** Enter the Timber Sale Licence (TSL) number in the **Search by Opportunity ID** field, then click the **Search** button.
- Step 5: Search for the TSL number in the Opportunity ID column in the search pane below.
- **Step 6**: Look for the **Issue Date** for that TSL under the **Issue Date** column. In the context of BC Bid, the term "Issued Date" means "Advertised Date" for the BCTS TSL.
