British Columbia export values are down -20% for October 2019 year to date (YTD) compared to the same period in 2018 (\$10.2 billion vs \$12.7 billion)

- Lumber export Value is down -26% while volumes are down -14%. The value of Other Wood Products is down -7% while log exports YTD are also down (-9%).
- *Pulp and paper export* Pulp value is down -22% and the value of paper products is also down (-9%).
- Value by destination United States (-21%), China (-14%), Japan (-22%) and other countries (-22%) are all down in October 2019 YTD.
- *Pulp Export Quantity (Table 6)* Overall volume of pulp exports declined by -2% YTD October 2019. For YTD September 2019, pulp export volumes flat at 0% compared to the same time last year.
- Export Quantities to China (Table 10) Compared to the same period last year, YTD export volumes to China are up. Softwood lumber volumes are flat at +0%, pulp increased by +7% and logs by +6% YTD October 2019. However, overall value of YTD exports to china is down -14%.









Figure 17: Pulp Export Quantity




Figure 19: Logs Export Quantity
