KAMLOOPS – The inquest into the death of Francis Eric Tucker has been scheduled. Mr. Tucker died on Aug. 12, 2007, following an incident at a logging site near Merritt.

The inquest is scheduled for March 22-25, 2010. Presiding coroner Tom Pawlowski and a jury will publicly hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses in order to determine the facts surrounding the death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
