Tecommend that pursuant to the Placer-Hining Act and Idinoral Act and all other powers thereunto enabling no person may on and after twelve o'clock noon on Tednesday, the lat day of Tovember, 1961, enter, locate, prospect or mine upon the following areas in the Cariboo, Chineca and Camboos Hining Divisions, or for any mineral therein:

All those lands situated in the Cariboo Land District, Cariboo Mining Division, being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the northerly boundary of the area defined in Section 11 of Order in Council 98, 1961, with the middle line of Cariboo River; thence easterly along the said northerly boundary of the area defined in Section 11 of Order in Council 98, 1961, to a point 3,000 feet perpendicularly distant casterly from the said middle line of Cariboo River; thence in a general northerly direction 3,000 feet persendicularly distant easterly from and parallel to the said middle line of Cariboo River to a point due cost of the outlet of Cariboo Labe; thence west to the 2,850-feet contour of elevation bounding said Cariboo Lake on the easterly shore thereof; thence in a general north-easterly, westerly and south-westerly direction along the said 2,850-foot contour of elevation bounding Cariboo Lake and Cariboo liver to a point due west of the outlet of said Cariboo Lake; thence to a point 5,000 feet perpendicularly distant westerly from the aforesaid middle line of Cariboo Myor; thence in a general southerly direction 3,000 feet perpendicularly distant westerly from and parallel to the said middle line of Cariboo liver to the westerly boundary of the aforesaid area defined in Section 11 of Order in Council 98, 1961. Thence northerly and easterly along the westerly and northerly boundaries of the aforesaid area defined in Section 11 of Order in Council 98, 1961, to the point of commencement.

All that portion of the watershed of the leGregor Hiver lying below the 2,470-foot contour which lies upstream of the area defined in Jection 1 of Order in Council 98, 1961.

- (2) To free piner shall corry on any mining operation within fifteen hundred feet of any dam, conduit, water tunnel, spillway or noter plant, or within five hundred feet of any transmission line or any other work or structure which may be prected in the prens reserved except will the permission of the Chief inspector of thes:
- (5) A person including the from or its exent, who builds or processes to build a day, conduit, water tunnel, or power plant, or transmission line, or ony ways, vorks, or structures in the areas reserved shall not interfere with or dislocate or obstruct any existing mining operation, plant, or equipment withouts
  - Inserting an advertisement of such intention in one issue of the British Columbia Cazette and in one issue of a newspaper circulating in the district in which the reserved areas are situated, not less than thirty days nor fore than ninety days before the actual start of the work or operation which will result in such interference, dislocation or obstruction takes place: end
  - (b) Giving at least ninety days notice in writing to the owner or holder of a mineral clain, lease or placer-mining clain, as the case may be, or his representative, which notice shall be deemed to have been ouf idently given if it is railed to the address noted upon the last tax notice issued in respect of a Crown-granted mineral plain or noted in the most resent relevent record of the Gold Commissioner, and any notice se given shall be deemed to have been received when, in the ordinary course of wail, it should have been delivered. To notice under this term or condition need be delivered to a free miner or leaned, or his representative, who records a placer claim or a mineral claim or applies for a mineral lease or files a notice of intention to apply for a placer-mining lease efter the insertion of the advertisements required by parayrach (5) (a) above:

- (4) The benefit of the conditions set forth in this order inures to the Grown and its agents, to persons contracting with the Grown with respect to the development of the areas reserved and to licencees under the mater Act":
- (5) The free edner shall before making application to record a placer claim or a mineral claim or before making application for a mineral lease or filing a notice of intention to apply for a placer lease, execute and deliver to the Gold Commissioner a release, in quadruplicate, in favour of Her Majesty in the right of Her Province of British Columbia, and licensees, assignees, exents and servants, from any cause of action, claim, demand or action, which he may at any time have or allege as the result of any exploration, development, whing or working of any area which may be included in a placer claim, a mineral claim, a placer lease or a mineral lease or as the result of occupation of any land for any purpose connected with the development of hydro-electric bower or as the result of any structure, operation, or mintenance of any work done or structure erected for any of the purposes set forth in paragraph (1).
