Community Gaming Grants 2010/11 Transition Details for Former Bingo Affiliates

Purpose

Effective April 1, 2010, the Province of British Columbia is consolidating the bingo affiliation and direct access grant programs into community gaming grants.

This document provides details concerning the transition of former bingo affiliates to community gaming grants.

It is organized into three parts to reflect the fiscal year during which affiliations end, including:

Part 1:

Community Organizations with a Former Bingo Affiliation that Expires on March 31, 2010;

Part 2:

Community Organizations with a Former Bingo Affiliation that Expires between April 1, 2010 and March 31, 2011; and

Part 3:

Community Organizations with a Former Bingo Affiliation that Expires after March 31, 2011.

Considerations

Organizations formerly receiving both a bingo affiliation grant and a direct access grant will be transitioned seamlessly to a single community gaming grant.

The approximately 100 organizations whose total grant(s) amount exceeds the Province's limits (\$100,000 for a local or regional organization, \$250,000 for a provincial organization) will be transitioned to the appropriate limit ASAP. Most groups will be moved in 2010/11, but the transition could take up to three years in some situations.
