EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 46 MAY 1974

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer-mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

(1) No person may locate a mineral claim, placer-mining claim or placer-mining lease in or upon the following described lands in the Skeena Mining Division, Queen Charlotte Land District:

Commencing at the most westerly northwest corner of Indian Reserve No. 6 (Ain), Queen Charlotte District; thence north 30° west 120 chains, more or less, to a point on the 200 ft. contour of elevation above sea level that surrounds Ian Lake; thence generally southwesterly, westerly, northeasterly and southerly around said contour to a point 136 chains north and 8 chains west of the said most westerly northwest corner of Indian Reserve No. 6; thence south 40° east 136 chains, more or less, to the shore of Massett Inlet; thence southwesterly along the natural boundary of said shore to the most easterly boundary of said Indian Reserve No. 6; thence northerly, westerly, southerly, and westerly around the boundary of said Indian Reserve No. 6 to the most westerly northwest corner thereof, that being the point of commencement.

and

(2) On and after the expiry of any existing mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location, and that this Order comes into operation with respect to each such location upon expiry.
