

THAT pursuant to the Mineral and Placer-mining Acts and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Nanaimo Mining Division, Douglas Land District:

That part of Block 202 more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the northerly boundary of Block 202, said point being 35 chains east of the most northerly northwest corner of said Block 202; thence due south 30 chains; thence due east 40 chains; thence north 30 chains more or less to the aforesaid northerly boundary of Block 202; thence westerly along the said northerly boundary of Block 202 to the aforesaid point of commencement;

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT on and after the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location and that this Order come into operation with respect to each such location upon such expiry.
