Whereas the lands described hereinafter are within Tree Farm Licence Number 23 and are found to be suitable for a park for the use, recreation, and enjoyment of the public.

And whereas the withdrawal of the aforementioned lands will in no way affect the sustained yield management of the said Tree Farm Licence.

Therefore pursuant to Subsection (14) Section 36 of the Forest Act being Chapter 153 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1960 and pursuant to Clause 9 of the said Tree Farm Licence Number 23 the following lands are hereby withdrawn from the lands described in Schedule "B" of the said Tree Farm Licence that is to say all those lands situated within Kootenay Land District shown outlined in red on the sketch map attached hereto and being more particularly described as follows:

"Commencing at a point on the east shore of Whatshan Lake approximately 20 chains south and 3 chains east of the easterly southwest corner of L. 9883; thence east 3 chains + to the Celgar road R/W; thence southerly along said R/W to Stevens Creek; thence following the right bank of Stevens Creek downstream to the shore of Whatshan Lake; thence following said lake shore northerly to point of commencement".

And the said lands so withdrawn are and shall be no longer subject to or form any part of the said Tree Farm Licence Number 23 during the lifetime of Special Use Permit Number 5407.
