

IN THE MATTER OF SECTION 33 OF THE MINERAL TENURE ACT R.S.B.C. 1996, CHAP 292

AND

IN THE MATTER OF PLACER CLAIM "MONAU" TITLE NUMBER 1073211

ORDER OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER

WHEREAS, Roger Peter Nutter, the recorded holder of placer claim title number 1073211 registered physical exploration and development work pursuant to the placer claim under Section 29 of the *Mineral Tenure Act* (the Act);

AND WHEREAS, Section 33(1) of the Act requires the recorded holder to submit a report in the form and manner prescribed by the regulations respecting this technical exploration and development;

AND WHEREAS notice was given to the recorded holder of the intention to cancel the registration of the recording of exploration and development if a report in the form and manner prescribed by the regulations was not submitted;

AND WHEREAS the recorded holder has not submitted a report in the form and manner as prescribed by the regulations;

- I, Donna Myketa, Chief Gold Commissioner for the Province of British Columbia, order the cancellation of the work credits recorded on event 5951735 based on the following:
 - Section 15(2) of the Mineral Tenure Act Regulation (the Regulation) states that a physical report must be submitted within 30 days from the date of registration of work in a format acceptable to the Chief Gold Commissioner.
 - Section 15(3) of the Regulation states that if the recorded holder fails to submit a report as required, the Chief Gold Commissioner may notify the recorded holder of the intention to cancel the registration of the recording of exploration and development under Section 33 of the Act.
 - On September 29, 2022, exploration and development was recorded as per Mineral Titles Online (MTO) event number 5951735.

- On December 27, 2022 Mr. Nutter was notified by email that a physical report had not been submitted and that if a report was not submitted within 14 days from the date of notice, the matter would be forwarded to the Chief Gold Commissioner for review.
- On January 12, 2023 Roger Nutter responded by saying that he had forgotten to send the report in; also he did not print a hard copy and his computer files had been corrupted. They were not retrievable. Mr. Nutter advised in the email to proceed with the cancellation.
- No other responses were received on the matter.
