DISPOSITION OF FUNDS RECEIVED FROM TRANSFER OF QUOTA TO ONTARIO – INSURANCE PRODUCT FOR AVIAN INFLUENZA

I write further to yesterday's telephone discussion concerning the subject.

The BC Farm Industry Review Board (BCFIRB) continues to review the March 8, 2013 letter of the BC Broiler Hatching Egg Commission requesting BCFIRB authorize the release of the subject funds for the purposes of supporting an avian influenza insurance program.

BCFIRB appreciates the significance to the industry of the proposed program. However, and as discussed at the April 19, 2013 meeting between BCFIRB and poultry board representatives, the proposal raises significant legal questions regarding jurisdiction under the *Natural Products Marketing (BC) Act.* Questions of similar significance arise with respect to "sound marketing policy". These are important questions for the four poultry boards as first instance regulators and for BCFIRB as the provincial supervisory agency.

BCFIRB continues to actively examine how these questions might be approached and potentially resolved in a timely way. BCFIRB next meets June 11-12, 2013 and this issue will again be on the board's agenda. I anticipate that BCFIRB will then be in a position to comment further on this subject.
