

Boundary Fisheries Least Risk Timing Windows

This document provides fisheries timing windows (i.e., least risk work windows) for waterbodies in the Boundary (Figure 1). These timing windows are important guidelines for minimizing the risk of impact to fish species and habitat. A qualified professional may be required if instream works are proposed outside of these timing windows. Consult the Kootenay Boundary Habitat Officer's Terms and Conditions for more information.

Windows of least risk for most waterbodies in the Boundary are listed in Table 1. If your works are occurring in Christina Lake, proximity to kokanee shore spawner habitat and proximity to the mouth of a spawning stream need to be considered. Shore spawner and creek spawner information is available online through *HabitatWizard*.

Information on fish presence and absence can be found in *HabitatWizard* and the *Fisheries Inventory Data Queries*.

Table 2. General work windows by fish species.

Species	Work Window
Mountain Whitefish	May 1 – Sept 30
Bull trout	June 1 – Aug 15
Burbot	June 1 – Dec 31
Trout – Rainbow, Steelhead, Cutthroat	July 22 – Oct 31
