Executive Summary

Vancouver Community College is pleased to submit its Carbon Neutral Action Report to the Government of British Columbia. The College supports the Provincial initiative to reduce Greenhouse Gas Emissions and is looking forward to working with Government further in this regard.

Management provides regular updates to the Board of Governors with respect to conservation and sustainability efforts. The College put in place an Environmental Sustainability Advisory Group. This group has taken on the task of providing advice to College administration on issues and initiatives related to conservation and sustainability. Membership includes a cross section of stakeholders, including Executive, Students, Faculty, Staff, Management and Volunteers. This group is responsible for providing policy advice to management on related issues.

College —wide initiatives are outlined in the following report. Notable achievements include the installation of energy-efficient hot water tanks at the College's new building at the Downtown Campus, participation in the BC Hydro Power Smart Study, completion of an energy efficient lighting retrofit project at the Broadway Campus, and providing employees with alternative transportation options. Other college wide initiatives include ongoing modernization each year to replace existing washroom fixtures with new water reducing fixtures, ensuring that over 80% of all paper products purchased are 30% recycled, implementation of online document management system called Sharepoint for all employees, introduction of electronic community college newsletter and implementation of electronic vendor payments.

Overviews

Actions Taken to Reduce Greenhouse Gas Emissions in 2009

- Began the installation of energy-efficient hot water tanks in the Downtown Campus.
- Completed lighting retrofit for the entire Broadway Campus using more energy efficient equipment, T8's, electronic ballasts, occupation sensors and LED emergency exit lights.
- Installed approximately 75 new bicycle security racks in 2009.
- Encouraged employee participation in Translink's Employer Pass Program, a fare reduction initiative provided by VCC and provided 2 parking lot spaces for the use of "Zip" cars as an alternative to driving a personal vehicle.

Operational Changes in 2009

In January 2009, the College commissioned 130,000 square foot of new additional educational space in the form of a high energy- efficient Health Sciences building, and thereby increasing the overall GHG emission.

Plans to Continue Reducing Greenhouse Gas Emissions 2010 – 2012

- Apply auto-sleep settings on printers, copiers, fax machines, and/or multi-function devices.
- Replace computers with ENERGY STAR models during regular computer upgrades and replace other appliances or electronic devices with ENERGY STAR models or source ENERGY STAR models for future purchases.
- Complete Direct Digital Control (DDC) installation at the Broadway Campus to improve heating and ventilation and reduce energy consumption.
- Replace the Downtown Campus atrium and library roof glass to improve customer comfort level.
- Replace large sections of the Broadway Campus building envelope to improve insulation properties of building and to improve energy consumption.
- Plan to modernize approximately 7 washrooms each year to reduce water consumption.
- Install high efficiency boilers at the Broadway Campus to decrease consumption of natural gas.
- Implement strategy to install DDC controls at the Downtown Campus by approximately 15% annually.
