Pursuant to Section 38 of the Coroners Act, the following recommendations are forwarded to the Chief Coroner of the Province of British Columbia for distribution to the appropriate agency:

JURY RECOMMENDATIONS:

To: Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General

- 1. Provide extended training to probation officers in mental health disorders and addictions.
- 2. Review and develop mental health agency relationships/partnerships with health authorities and other agencies to provide additional tools and supports to probation officers and their clients.
- 3. Conduct Coroner's inquests in a timely manner.
- 4. Capture by audio, visual, and other means events involving Emergency Response Team members.

To: RCMP E Division

- 5. Create and implement positions for full time negotiators to be scheduled in a manner that ensures a full team is available, without delay, and in a manner that provides for training in accordance with recognized and emerging standards.
- 6. Ensure that the Emergency Response Team has access to explosive devices without delay.

To: E-Comm 9-1-1

7. Ensure call-takers are trained to play back recorded 911 calls related to critical incidents to crisis negotiation teams for proper triage, assessment, and further action.
