British Columbia export values are down -7% for April 2019 year to date (YTD) compared to the same period in 2018 (\$4.3 billion vs \$4.7 billion)

- Lumber export is down -10% while volumes are down -1%. The value of Other Wood Products is down -9% while log exports YTD are down (-13%).
- *Pulp and paper export* Pulp value is down -4% and while the value of paper products is up (+5%).
- Value by destination United States (-12%), Japan (-13%) and other countries (-7%) are down while China (+2%) has increased.

- Lumber value decline (Table 3) The +24% increase in YTD value exports to China did not mitigate the decline for all other countries including the US and Japan.
- Paper product share of value (Table 4) The YTD export value to the US has declined making up 49% total YTD paper exports (63% April 2018 YTD) with China up at 20% compared to 12% April 2018 YTD.
- China's country share (Table 8) There was an increase in share of overall export values to 31% in April 2019 YTD compared to 28% in April 2018 YTD.


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


Figure 1: Total Export Value \$16.0 \$1.6 Monthly Value (lines), C\$ billions \$1.4 C\$ billions \$1.2 \$12.0 \$10.0 \$1.0 (bars) \$0.8 \$8.0 \$0.6 \$6.0 \$4.0 \$0.4 \$2.0 \$0.2 \$0.0 \$0.0 Jan Feb Mar Apr May Jun Jul Aug Sep Oct Nov Dec 2018 - YTD 2019 - YTD •••• • 2018 - Monthly 2019 - Monthly


Figure 7: Other Wood Export Value \$0.3 \$3.0 Monthly Value (lines), C\$ billions C\$ billions \$2.5 \$0.2 \$2.0 \$0.2 TD Value (bars), \$1.5 \$0.1 \$1.0 \$0.1 \$0.5 \$0.0 \$0.0 Jan Feb Mar Apr May Jun Jul Aug Sep Oct Nov Dec 2018 - YTD 2019 - YTD •••• 2018 - Monthly 2019 - Monthly






Figure 12: Log Export Value -




Figure 18: Pulp Export Quantity - 12 Month Moving Sum




Figure 19: Logs Export Quantity




Figure 20: Log Export Quantity - 12 Month Moving Sum
