

Charles Wood (the “Respondent”)

The Respondent was alleged to have acted incompetently or breached a term or condition of his licence when attending a call on or about July 19, 2020.

As a result, on May 30, 2022, with the agreement of the Respondent, the Respondent’s licence was suspended for eight (8) shifts and he was required to complete and submit to the Emergency Medical Assistants’ Licensing Board (the “Board”) a research paper within 30 days of May 30, 2022, and attend a meeting with a Branch-appointed resource person within 90 days of the Board approving the research paper.
