## Are you prepared?

2024 is coming sooner than you think and bringing with it some significant changes regarding workplace health and safety requirements.

As of January 1, 2024, anyone doing asbestos abatement work in B.C. will need to be certificated through an provider. approved training Also effective January 1, 2024, an employer and injured worker will be required to co-operate with each other and with WorkSafeBC to facilitate the worker's return to their pre-injury job, а comparable job or other suitable work. Employers with 20 or more workers will also have a duty under the Workers Compensation Act to maintain employment, by providing accommodation of injured workers, up to the point of undue hardship.

As of **November 1, 2024**, employers will need to meet new minimum first aid requirements set out in the *OHS Regulation*. The changes are detailed on WorkSafeBC's website: <u>Part 3 –</u> <u>Minimum Levels of First Aid</u>
