AMENDMENT NO. 17

Whereas a parcel of unsurveyed Crown land in the vicinity of
Hotham Sound, New Westminster Land District, is within Tree Farm Licence
Number 39 and is found to be suitable for a higher economic use than
the growing of forest crops and whereas the withdrawal of the aforementioned
land in no way affects the sustained yield management of the said Tree
Farm Licence.

Therefore pursuant to Subsection (14) of Section 36 of the "Forest Act" being Chapter 153 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1960 and Clause 11 of the said Tree Farm Licence Number 39, the following lands are herewith withdrawn from the said Tree Farm Licence namely all that parcel or tract of land situated in New Westminster Land District being more particularly shown outlined in bold black on the attached sketch and described as follows:

"Commencing at a point on the westerly shore of Hotham Sound, Jervis Inlet, New Westminster Land District; said point being approximately 106.5 chains north and 14 chains east from the most northerly northwest corner of Lot 3256; thence west 5 chains; thence south 10 chains; thence east 6 chains more or less to the westerly shore of Hotham Sound; thence in a general northerly direction along the said westerly shore to the point of commencement."

and the said lands so withdrawn are and shall be no longer subject to or form any part of the said Tree Farm Licence during the life of Special Use Permit 4656.


CAMPSITE AND LOG DUMP AREA
