BURNABY – The inquest into the death of Paul Glenn Boyd has been scheduled. Mr. Boyd was shot during an incident with the Vancouver Police Department. Despite medical treatment, he died on Aug. 13, 2007.

The inquest is scheduled for Dec. 13-17, 2010. Presiding coroner Owen Court and a jury will publicly hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses in order to determine the facts surrounding the death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
