Your Woodlot Licence Plan (WLP) extension for Woodlot Licence W1968 has now been fully reviewed.

## **Determination:**

I am satisfied that the plan has been prepared and submitted in accordance with Section 13 of the *Forest and Range Practices Act* (FRPA) and the regulations. Accordingly, as the statutory decision-maker authority under Section 16 of the FRPA, I am approving your WLP extension and amendment.

The Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development remain committed to a meaningful consultation process with First Nations who may assert traditional aboriginal interests in an area covered by this WLP. The particulars of this WLP have been communicated to the appropriate First Nations and their input has been encouraged. To date, I have not been advised of any site-specific aboriginal interests that may be infringed upon by the proposed development described in this WLP.

The term of this plan has been extended from February 11, 2018, to February 10, 2028. Further development taking place on Woodlot Licence W1968 must be done in accordance with the approved WLP.
