The undersigned has the honour to recommend that pursuant to Section 14 (5) of the "Mineral Act", and Section 16 (1) of the "Placer-mining Act" chapters 213 and 214 of the revised Statutes of British Columbia 1948, respectively, a reservation be placed upon all minerals in the following areas: namely
