On the recommendation of the undersigned, the *** Manual Threshold by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

> The following described lands in the Skeena Mining l. Division, Queen Charlotte Land District are established as a mineral reserve and as a placer mining reserve:

Commencing at the most Westerly point on the natural boundary of Tasu Head on Moresby Island; thence due East to the Southwesterly boundary of the watershed of Tasu Sound; thence in a general Southeasterly and Easterly direction along said watershed boundary to the point of intersection with the Southerly boundary of the watershed Crescent Inlet; thence Easterly along the Southerly boundary of the Crescent Inlet to the Southerly boundary of Lot 663, Queen Charlotte Land District; thence Easterly along Southerly to the Southeast corner of Lot 663, Queen Charlotte Land District; thence due East with the natural boundary of Horesby Island, on the Easterly shore thereof; thence Northeasterly along the natural boundary of Moresby Island, on the Easterly shore thereof, to a point due East of the Triangulation Station "Fin" situated on Crescent Point; thence Northeasterly in a straight line to a point 600 m due North of Triangulation Station Holms "12"; thence Southeasterly in a straight line to Triangulation Station "Cas", located on the Easterly shore of Richardson Island; thence in a straight line at a bearing of 150 to the natural boundary of Lyell Island, on the Northwesterly shore thereof; thence in a straight line at a bearing of , a distance of 10 000 m; thence in a straight line

at a bearing of 225° a distance of 2300 m; thence Southeasterly in a straight line to the most Easterly point on the natural boundary of the largest island in the Bischof Islands group; thence Northeasterly in a straight line to the point of intersection between the 131° 30' Meridian of West Longitude with the natural boundary of Lyell Island, on the Southeasterly shore thereof; thence Easterly and Northerly along the natural boundary of Lyell Island, to a point due East of the Triangulation Station "Ful", located on Fuller Point; thence in a straight line at a bearing of 80° a distance of 10 000 m; thence Southeasterly in a straight line to a point 4000 m due East of the most Easterly point on the natural boundary of Benjamin Point on the Easterly shore of Moresby Island; thence Southerly in a straight line to a point 5000 m due East of the most Southerly point on the natural boundary of the most Southerly island of the Kerouard Islands; thence due South 500 m (in a straight line); thence due West 13 000 m; thence at a bearing of 320°, to a point due West of the most Westerly point on the natural boundary of Tasu Head; thence due East to the point of commencement.

- 2. The lands described are established as a mineral reserve and as a placer mining reserve until July 31, 1988.
- 3. No free miner shall stake or acquire a location or record or locate a mineral claim in the reserve created by Section 1.
