 - 9. Referral material under section 16(4) or section 16(5) including:
 - a. Report
 - b. Notification, if any, by a participating Indigenous nation of consent or lack of consent
 - c. Information, if any, respecting an arrangement reached with a participating Indigenous nation
 - 10. Order under section 17
 - 11. Notice provided under section 27(2)(b)
 - 12. Revised application accepted under section 27(4)
 - 13. Any supplementary information in final form filed by the proponent at the request of the Chief Executive Assessment Officer for the purposes of completing the assessment
 - 14. Referral materials under 29(2), including
 - a. Final assessment report and environmental assessment certificate, with certificate conditions and project description
 - b. Recommendations respecting whether the project is consistent with promotion of sustainability

 - c. for any other document referred, within 7 days after the Chief Executive Assessment Officer receives or approves it.
- 2. Public notice means notice of a formal public comment period, open house, or public meeting and must be provided:
 - 1. for public comment periods specified in section 23, at least 7 days before the start of a public comment period or the date on which an open house or public meeting is scheduled
 - 2. for any other public comment period, in the time required by the Chief Executive Assessment Officer
 - 3. in the form of newspaper advertisement, open letters or any other manner satisfactory to the Chief Executive Assessment Officer
