Management teams may delegate policies to specific positions within the authority level at their discretion. However, the authority delegation should be reviewed annually to confirm appropriate levels. Delegation outside an authority level is determined by the Executive Director, given specific circumstances (i.e.: no delegate available) and should be on a temporary basis.

Determination of authority levels to guidelines. Determination is based on meeting majority of criteria ('or', not 'and'). Individual categories may be determined based on an extreme weighting on one particular category.

Political Risk: Low

Manager Level

Procedures are complex

Relating to life threatening need or child

concerns Volume: Low

Financial Risk: High Client Impact: High Political Risk: High

Supervisor Level

Procedures are clear Volume: Medium - High

Financial Risk: Moderate – High Client Impact: Moderate – High Political Risk: Low – Moderate

Director Level

Financial Risk: Extreme

Client Impact: High - Extreme

Political Risk: Extreme

To be determined on case by case basis

Executive Director Level

Financial Risk: Extreme

Client Impact: High - Extreme
