CORONER'S INQUEST INTO THE DEATH OF JOHN SEGUIN SCHEDULED

VICTORIA – The Coroner's inquest into the death of John James Lionel Seguin has been scheduled. Mr. Seguin was shot while being pursued by Victoria Police. He died on Feb. 3, 2007.

The inquest is scheduled for Nov. 13-16, 2007. Presiding coroner Norm Leibel and a five-person jury will publicly hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses in order to determine the facts surrounding the death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
