CORONER'S INQUEST INTO THE DEATH OF ROWEN VON NIEDERHAUSERN

TERRACE – The Coroner's inquest into the death of 14-month-old Rowen Von Niederhausern has been scheduled. On Aug. 16, 2002, Rowen was found unresponsive while sleeping. He was taken to Mills Memorial Hospital in Terrace where he was pronounced dead.

The inquest is scheduled for June 18 - 22. Presiding coroner Marj Paonessa and a five-person jury will publicly hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses in order to determine the facts surrounding the death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
