

SUMMARY: FILE REVIEW

Of the Death of a Youth Known to the Director in 2018

Circumstances of the Fatality

The review examined the case files of an Indigenous youth who died from a health issue following their nineteenth birthday. The Delegated Aboriginal Agency (DAA) was providing services to the youth in relation to their transition from the director's care, which included accessing health services. While participating in health treatment services, the youth turned nineteen. The DAA continued to provide a circle of support post age of majority.

Findings

The youth's needs were assessed in conjunction with a thorough Care Plan which documented the medical and health challenges, as well as the supports required during the transition to adulthood. A planning circle utilized the support of family, community services, and health professionals. The DAA supported the youth by providing regular, collaborative, and coordinated services.

Actions

The findings of the file review did not identify areas that required any actions.

The review was completed in November 2019.
