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British Columbia export values are down -18% for August 2019 year to date (YTD) compared to the same period in 2018 (\$8.4 billion vs \$10.2 billion)

- Lumber export Value is down -25% while volumes are down -11%. The value of Other Wood Products is down -5% while log exports YTD are also down (-9%).
- *Pulp and paper export* Pulp value is down -18% and the value of paper products is also down (-5%).
- Value by destination United States (-21%), China (-10%), Japan (-18%) and other countries (-18%) are all down in August 2019 YTD.
- Log export volume (Table 10) Overall quantity of logs exported in August 2019 YTD have declined (-8%). The



decline was somewhat mitigated by the increase in log export volumes to China which was up **+4%** in August 2019 YTD.

- **Softwood lumber share (Table 4)** The US share of softwood lumber export value was **59%** in August 2019 YTD compared to **63%** the same time last year. Meanwhile, China's share went up for this time period to **18%** compared to **14%** in August 2018 YTD.
- Export volumes to China (Table 10) In addition to the increase in YTD log exports, lumber (+9%) and pulp (+7%) export volumes to China also increased. However, export values continue to lag behind last year's levels due to lower export prices.


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
Export Values by Product and Destination

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



Figure 14: Exchange Rate C\$/US\$





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Export Quantities by Product and Destination



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


Figure 19: Logs Export Quantity
