On February 20, 2018, Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy, Environmental Protection Division staff conducted an office review inspection of your facility, Keltic Seafoods Limited located at Port Hardy Fish Processing Plant with authorization number 2499 under the Environmental Management Act.
