

When to Claim the Drug Administration Fee

This resource should be read in conjunction with Section 8.10 (Pharmacist administration of drugs and vaccines) of the PharmaCare Policy Manual, and HPA Bylaw Schedule F Part 4 (Drug Administration by Injection and Intranasal Route Standards, Limits and Conditions). Examples are not comprehensive.

- The drug administration fee **cannot be claimed** for:
- Vaccines indicated for travel
 - Insulins
 - Low molecular weight heparins (LMWH)
 - Glucagon-like peptide-1 receptor agonists (e.g., semaglutide, tirzepatide, dulaglutide)
 - Products designed for patient self-injection (e.g., auto-injector, pen)
