EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 17. MAR. 1977

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that Order in Council 3938 approved December 8, 1969, and Order in Council 745 approved March 9, 1970, each be amended by

(1) deleting in paragraph 2 the words "An area 10 miles wide, being 5 miles on each side of the proposed right of way for the Pacific Great Eastern Railway" and substituting therefore the words "An area 160 metres wide, being 80 metres on each side of the centerline of the cleared or constructed grade location for the British Columbia Railway," and

(2) deleting in paragraph 2 the words "as shown on plan attached."

And further orders that Order in Council 1213 approved April 9, 1970, be cancelled.
