




Required when:	A guide outfitter wants to designate a person to submit guide outfitter reports on their behalf. A guide outfitter wants to designate a person to purchase licences for their clients on their behalf, at FrontCounter BC and Service BC locations.
Who is eligible to submit?	A Guide Outfitter who has held a guide licence in the BC Hunting online service.
Fee	There is no fee to assign a designate.




Before you start

Before you assign a person to be a designate, make sure you have:

- An active Fish and Wildlife ID with verified user status.
- A Guide Outfitter Licence.

Log in to your Fish and Wildlife profile from the B.C. Hunting homepage at www.gov.bc.ca/hunting.

Next, click on **Designates** under **Commercial Product Options** on the left-hand side of your profile home page.



Add a Designate

 Select Add a designate, to search for the individual you would like to assign as a designate.

NOTE: The individual you would like to assign as a designate must have a valid and verified Fish and Wildlife ID.


Guide Outfitter Designate Registration





Search for the Individual

- Enter the Fish and Wildlife ID (FWID), last name and first initial of the person you would like to add as a designate.
- Click the **Find** button.
- Select the tick boxes next to the functionality you give consent for the individual to perform on your behalf.
- Click the **Save & Close** button.



Designate Has Been Added

 You will see the list of designate(s) that you have authorized to perform business functions on your behalf.

NOTE: You can assign and remove designate functions at any time by clicking on the designate name.
