# School District No. 20 Kootenay Columbia – 2011 Carbon Neutral Action Report

## **Executive Summary**

School District No. 20 is committed to continuing on the path of implementing changes to our stationary buildings, our mobile fleet, our procurement and delivery of supplies and services which will reduce our carbon emissions and our energy consumption.

As an educational leader in our area of the province, we wish to lead by example by modeling a sustainable lifestyle and teaching our students and staff how sustainability can be achieved in all aspects of our lives.

We fully expect the results of our efforts will help to maintain and improve our beautiful local environment and improve the service we provide to our students by reducing utility and carbon offset costs which will free up funds that may be redirected to support student achievement.

#### 2011 Greenhouse Gas Emissions

School District No 20's total GHG emissions from all sources for 2011 are 2519 tonnes

#### Offsets Applied to Become Carbon Neutral in 2011

Total emission offsets of 2073 tonnes have been applied to become carbon neutral for 2011. As required by section 5 of the Carbon Neutral Government regulation 446 tonnes of CO2e of emissions resulting from the operation of school buses were reported as part of our greenhouse gas emissions profile in 2011. However, they were not offset as they are out-of-scope under section 4(2)(c) of the Carbon Neutral Government Regulation.

#### **Emissions Reduction Activities**

## Actions Taken to Reduce Greenhouse Gas Emissions in 2011

- We purchased only paper that had recycled content.
- -We surveyed our automated Heating Ventilation and Air Conditioning controls and made adjustments to reduce our emissions and utility costs.
  - -We reinforced our anti idling campaign.

-We worked to streamline our school bus runs to reduce the daily kilometres travelled in order to reduce fuel use and emissions.

# Plans to Continue Reducing Greenhouse Gas Emissions 2012-2014

Our School District plans to continue with the initiatives already in place and to focus more closely on sustainable lifestyles and practices by implementing a program such as Destination Conservation to help educate and encourage our students and staff towards further conservation practices that can be used in the district and elsewhere. We will also be focusing on reducing our stationary and Mobile emissions by working on updating our District Energy Management Action Plan of 2006 to identify energy use and GHG emission areas of priority for improvements and purchasing and implementing a school bus routing software program to more efficiently deploy our fleet.


