Currently, there are **253** agencies that receive \$500,000 or more in contract funding from the Ministry of Children and Family Development (MCFD) and/or Community Living British Columbia (CLBC) and are accredited. Additionally, there are **three** agencies that receive less than \$500,000 in MCFD and/or CLBC contract funding that are not required to be accredited and have done so voluntarily and at their own expense. ACCREDITATION POLICY UPDATE

The Accreditation Program <u>policy</u> was updated May 7, 2024. The main purpose was to provide clarity on roles/responsibilities and oversight/monitoring measures. There is no change to the work of CARF and Social Current (COA) with MCFD and/or CLBC funded agencies.

The impact on agencies is minimal, though important clarification/language was added to two main areas:

- The maximum length of an extension that will now be granted, especially for newly accrediting organizations, and
- 2. The consequences for not achieving or maintaining accreditation within the prescribed timeframe (2 years after being notified).

PROGRAM ACCREDITATION

As of April 1, 2023, only MCFD and/or CLBC funded services are required to be accredited or reaccredited. This change applies to both newly accrediting and reaccrediting organizations. Services not funded by MCFD and/or CLBC may be added at the organization's own expense. There will be no change to the support organizations receive, or their access to the online portal and peer mentorship.

Additionally, please remember that all services funded by MCFD and/or CLBC must be accredited.
