- 1. The defendants Asuma LLC and Stichting All Saints University of Medicine Aruba Foundation are permanently enjoined and restrained from doing the following without the consent of the Minister of Advanced Education:
 - a. advertising programming, or parts of programming, in written or oral form, at Aureus Academic Centre ("AAC") in British Columbia, or elsewhere in British Columbia, of any portion of a medical or other degree program;
 - b. using the term "university", or any derivation or abbreviation thereof, to indicate that an educational program, or portion of an educational program, of a medical or other degree is available at AAC in British Columbia, or elsewhere in British Columbia;

- c. providing a program, or any portion of a program, leading to a medical or other degree anywhere in British Columbia, including but not limited to the first year of a five year medical degree program offered at AAC in British Columbia; and,
- 2. No costs shall be payable by any party.
