

You can still filter your search by a specific client number, payment method type (cash/cheque or credit card) with a specific date range, but when you get to the results screen you will notice a difference.

From the main MTO screen, click on the **Reports** tab and select the **Payment Receipts** option.



After defining the selection criteria and clicking next, your report will appear. You will notice that we've added an option to download the report into Microsoft Excel or as an Adobe PDF.



On the report itself we have included the Tenure Type, Event Type and Tenure numbers for the associated Invoice.

Confirmation Emails

After registering an event in MTO a confirmation email will be sent to the email address you have listed in MTO. These confirmation emails have all been greatly improved.

Each event transaction confirmation email will contain the Event Number, Event Type description and recording date. For those transactions requiring payment, the transaction details (invoice number, amount and payment method) will be listed at the bottom of the page. Where possible, links from the confirmation email directly back to MTO were included.

- (a) the search for a mineral or placer mineral,
- (b) the exploration and development of a mineral or placer mineral, or
- (c) the production of a mineral or placer mineral,

and includes the reclamation of a previously mined area and the monitoring and long term protection, control and treatment of a previously mined area.


Addition of new Layers for display

First Nations Treaty Lands and First Nations Treaty Related Lands




