Sd 10 has been working on projects that help reduce emissions. New boiler upgrades and efficient heating/ cooling systems. We have also continued adding solar power to almost all our buildings. Our big projects involve engineers and I have them try to continue to improve our emissions.

B. Mobile Sources (e.g. fleet vehicles, off-road/portable equipment)

Sd 10 has purchase 3 electric busses and have had 2 on the road since the beginning of the year. This has helped with our diesel consumption. As we learn how far we can go on these buses, we have decided to purchase 1 more this coming year to add to another one of our routes. We have done a feasibility study and can add 2 more electric buses to our fleet to help with emissions. We now are looking at purchasing electric white fleet to phase out our other vehicles. Sd 10 is also looking into battery powered lawnmores.

C. Paper Consumption

Sd 10 has started to transition paper filing into electronic. Slow process but we are winning. We have discussed with schools using both sides of the paper and are looking at what percentage of recycled paper we are getting. This year was a huge reduction by using up old stock from the past years.
