



report

MM&T pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer-mining Act and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Kamloops Mining Division:

Firstly: Commencing at the S.E. corner of Spatsum Indian Reserve No. 11; thence easterly along the easterly prolongation of the southerly boundary of said Indian Reserve No. 11 to the easterly boundary of Section 31, Township 18, Range 24, W.M.; thence northerly along the easterly boundary of said Section 31 to the north east corner thereof; thence westerly along the northerly boundary of said Section 31 to the easterly boundary of Spatsum Indian Reserve No. 11A; thence southerly along the easterly boundary of Spatsum Indian Reserve No. 11A to the northerly boundary of Spatsum Indian Reserve No. 11; thence easterly and southerly along the northerly and easterly boundary of said Indian Reserve No. 11 to the south east corner thereof; being the point of commencement.

Secondly: Commencing at the N.E. corner of Section 30, Township 18, Range 24, W.M.; thence due east 1½ miles; thence due south 2 miles; thence due west to the easterly limit of the C.P.R. Railway right-of-way; thence northerly along the easterly limit of the said C.P.R. Railway right-of-way to a point due west of the north east corner of the aforesaid Section 30; thence easterly to said north east corner of Section 30; being the point of commencement.

Thirdly: Commencing at the north east corner of Section 32, Township 18, Range 24, W.M.; thence due east 6 miles; thence due south 4 miles; thence due west 2½ miles; thence due south to a point 10 chains perpendicularly distant northerly from the northerly limit of the right-of-way shown on Plan G.G. 1065 on file in the Land Registry Office, Kamloops; thence westerly parallel to and 10 chains perpendicularly distant northerly from the northerly limit of said right-of-way to the easterly boundary of aforesaid Section 32; thence northerly along the easterly boundary of said Section 32 to the north east corner thereof; being the point of commencement.

except in accordance with and subject to the following terms and conditions:

No holder of a mineral claim, or a placer-mining claim or lease that may hereafter be located within the area outlined above, shall be entitled to any surface rights whatsoever:

No holder of a mineral claim, or placer-mining claim or lease, that may hereafter be located within the area outlined above, or any person exploring, developing, mining or working in any way the said mineral claim, or placer-mining claim or lease, shall be entitled to any claim for damage which may be caused by the construction, operation and maintenance of a tailings disposal area, pipeline, water reservoir, road or power line or structure of any kind whatsoever which may come into existence on the said mineral claim, or placer-mining claim or lease:

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT upon the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease which lies within the areas outlined above, lands covered by any such mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease shall become and are hereby constituted a reservation under the terms of this Order.
