Executive Summary

The Sustainability and Energy Committees have continued their efforts to improve the sustainability of CNC operations. This includes advances within CNC's partnership with BC Hydro under their Energy Manager Program. Plans were developed in 2009 to begin implementation of energy conservation measures identified in 2008 energy audits. Several of these measures were completed in 2009. Design of two new LEED Gold buildings was initiated in 2009. Construction completion of these is expected in 2011.

Overviews

Actions Taken to Reduce Greenhouse Gas Emissions in 2009

Key initiatives undertaken in 2009 include:

- CNC's IT department completed numerous projects that reduce energy and paper consumption including
 installing and training staff on the use of video conferencing and paperless management software; setting
 printer and photocopier defaults to double-sided; purchasing server virtualisation software; applying auto-sleep
 settings on printers, copiers and fax machines;
- CNC initiated an Energy Awareness Program and established a volunteer Green Team.
- CNC commissioned a detailed feasibility study to identify and quantify energy conservation opportunities in
 upgrading the Prince George campus power plant that heats and cools the majority of buildings on that campus.
 CNC management is now evaluating the options presented and, depending on funding availability, hopes to
 move forward with the preferred option in 2010.
- In 2009 the Prince George campus was identified as a good candidate for BC Hydro's Continuous Optimisation Program. CNC began work in compiling applications to BC Hydro for two buildings under this program. These applications will be submitted to BC Hydro in 2010.
- Designs were completed for two new Trades Buildings one on the Prince George campus and one on the Quesnel campus. These buildings are targeting LEED Gold certification.
- Three energy conservation measures identified in 2008 Prince George campus audit were implemented in 2009: holiday schedules programmed into DDCs; domestic hot water piping insulated; and, air handling unit AHU-720 operating hours aligned with space usage.
- A T12 to T8 fluorescent lighting retrofit was completed in March 2009 at the Prince George campus. A lighting retrofit of the Prince George gymnasium was initiated in late 2009 for completion in early 2010.
- As additional energy savings measures, building automation systems at the Prince George campus were adjusted for holiday schedules and air handling unit AHU-720 operating hours were aligned.

Plans to Continue Reducing Greenhouse Gas Emissions 2010 – 2012

CNC will be focusing on the following key areas of greenhouse gas reduction over the next three years:

- Continuing development of a long-term strategic energy management plan including prioritising and implementing energy conservation capital projects as funding allows;
- Improving awareness and engagement of staff and students regarding energy and greenhouse gas reduction;
- Aligning CNC policy with energy and greenhouse gas reduction plans.
