2001 Census of Agriculture: Results For British Columbia

Initial results from the 2001 Census of Agriculture released mid-May 2002 by Statistics Canada include the following highlights for British Columbia:

Farm Numbers

- ⇒ The total number of farms in British Columbia has decreased by 7 percent to 20,290 in 2001, from 21,835 in 1996.
- ⇒ The number of non-family corporation farms decreased 44 percent from 573 to 323 farms.
- ⇒ Family controlled farms decreased by 6 percent from 21,175 to 19,880. These represent 98 percent of all British Columbia farms.
- ⇒ The large commercial sized farms in British Columbia with sales of \$500,000 and over, increased by 23 percent from 805 to 989.

Farmland

- ⇒ Total land in farms expanded by 2 percent to a total of 2.587 million hectares (6.393 million acres). The area under crops increased by 9 percent (or 51,807 hectares) due mainly to a 6 percent decline in the area under summerfallow.
- ⇒ The area of owned land decreased 2 percent to 1.525 million hectares (3.768 million acres) and rented/leased land increased by almost 10 percent to 1.062 million hectares (2.624 million acres).
- ⇒ The increase in total farmland reported by a fewer total number of farms than in 1996 meant that the average size of farm in British Columbia was larger, showing an increase from 116 hectares in 1996 to 128 hectares in 2001.

Land Management Practices

- ⇒ There were 4,193 less hectares of farmland irrigated in 2001 than in 1996 and 14,800 less hectares of commercially fertilized farmland. British Columbia had the second largest farm area under irrigation among the provinces and the smallest farm area commercially fertilized among the larger provinces.
- ⇒ Improved soil practices were more evident in 2001. The area of no-tillage increased by 61 percent, and the area of conservation tillage retaining most of the residue on surface, decreased by 2 percent. The area subject to manuring increased by 11 percent. Additionally, the increase in the area to which pesticides were applied was smaller than in earlier census years.

Farm Capital

⇒ The value of farm capital in British Columbia in 2001 was \$15.8 billion an increase of 14.5 percent. This increase reflected mainly the higher values of land and buildings.

Farm Labor

- ⇒ The amount of paid labor increased by 9 percent and the number of farms reporting such labor decreased by 8 percent. In other words, the amount of paid labor per farm increased.
- ⇒ Year round labor increased by 16 percent, much faster than seasonal labor, reflecting an increased full-time labor force.

Farm Enterprises and Production

- ⇒ Among types of enterprises, there were increases in farms producing beef, poultry and eggs, and field crops other than grain and oilseed. On the other hand, there were fewer farms in specialty crops and livestock such as mushrooms, greenhouse products, nursery products, Christmas trees and game farm animals. The number of hog farms also continued to decline.
- ⇒ The total cattle on farms increased slightly. Beef cow numbers were up by 2.4 percent but dairy cow numbers were down by 13 percent reflecting higher cow productivity. Poultry on farms were up 37 percent. Hog numbers declined by 4.8 percent while sheep and lamb numbers increased by 16 percent.
- ⇒ The crop production base expanded with significant growth in the area planted in forage seed, ginseng, berries, grapes, greenhouse products and nursery products. However, the overall area in field crops declined by 146,188 hectares or 27 percent, reflecting a drop in tame hay and in grain and oilseeds area.
- ⇒ The market value of agricultural products sold by British Columbia farms increased to \$2.3 billion in 2001 compared with \$1.8 billion in 1996. Operating expenses reached \$2.1 billion compared with \$1.7 billion in 1996. Thus the ratio of operating expenses to gross farm receipts increased slightly from 1996.

Organic Farms

⇒ The question on certified organic farming was new in 2001. There were a total of 319 farms reporting organic products. Eighty-four percent were producing fruits, vegetables or greenhouse products while field crops were reported on 22 percent of these farms and animal products on 16 percent. [Due to both response errors and undercoverage the number of farms reporting certified organic products for sale is under reported in the census].

Farm Business Management

⇒ There were 8,146 British Columbia farms using computers, slightly more than 40 percent of the total number of farms. The proportion is up from 24 percent in 1996. Word processing, bookkeeping and the internet were the most popular uses. British Columbia ranked third (after Quebec and Alberta) in the farm use of personal computers among the provinces.
