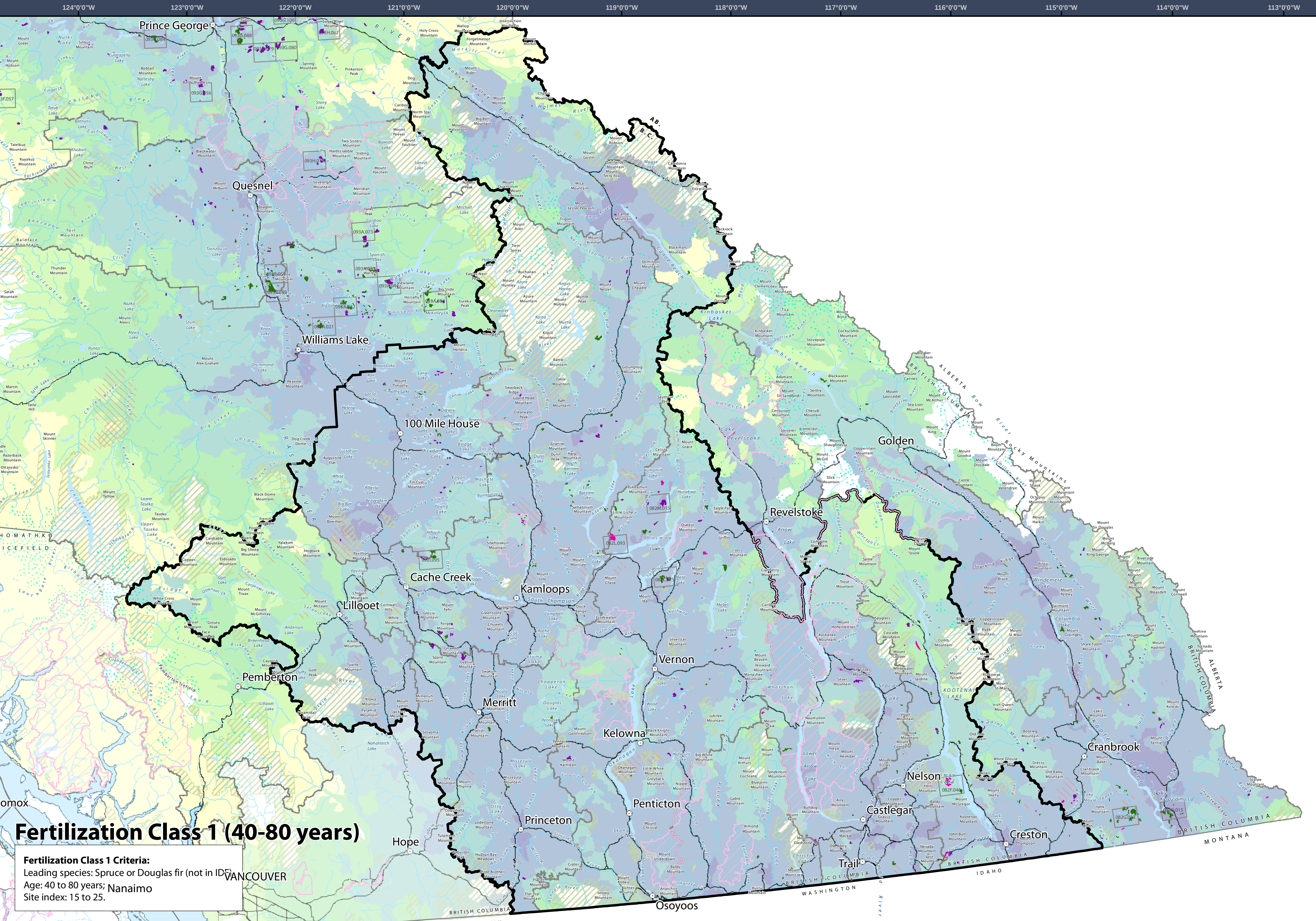


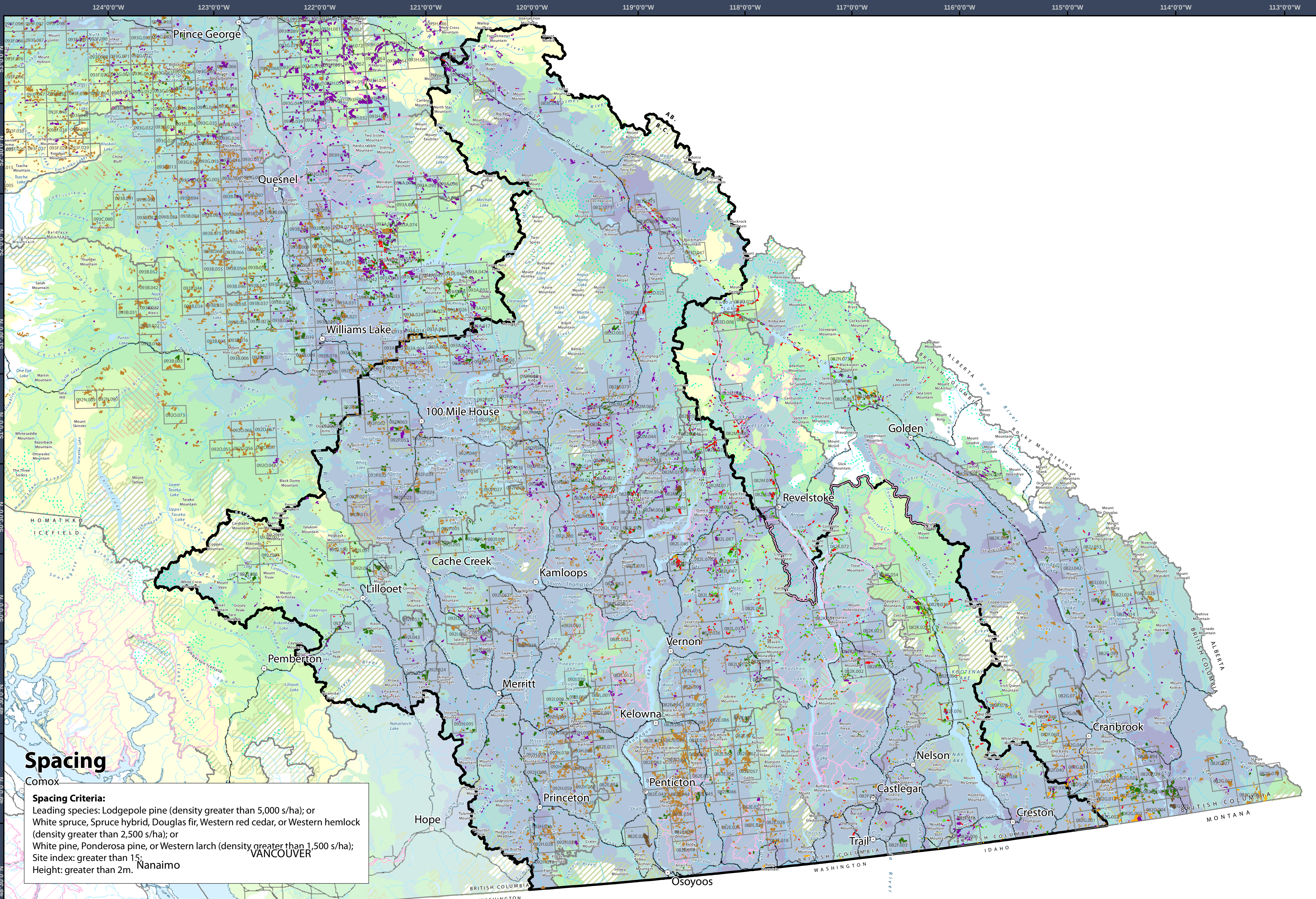

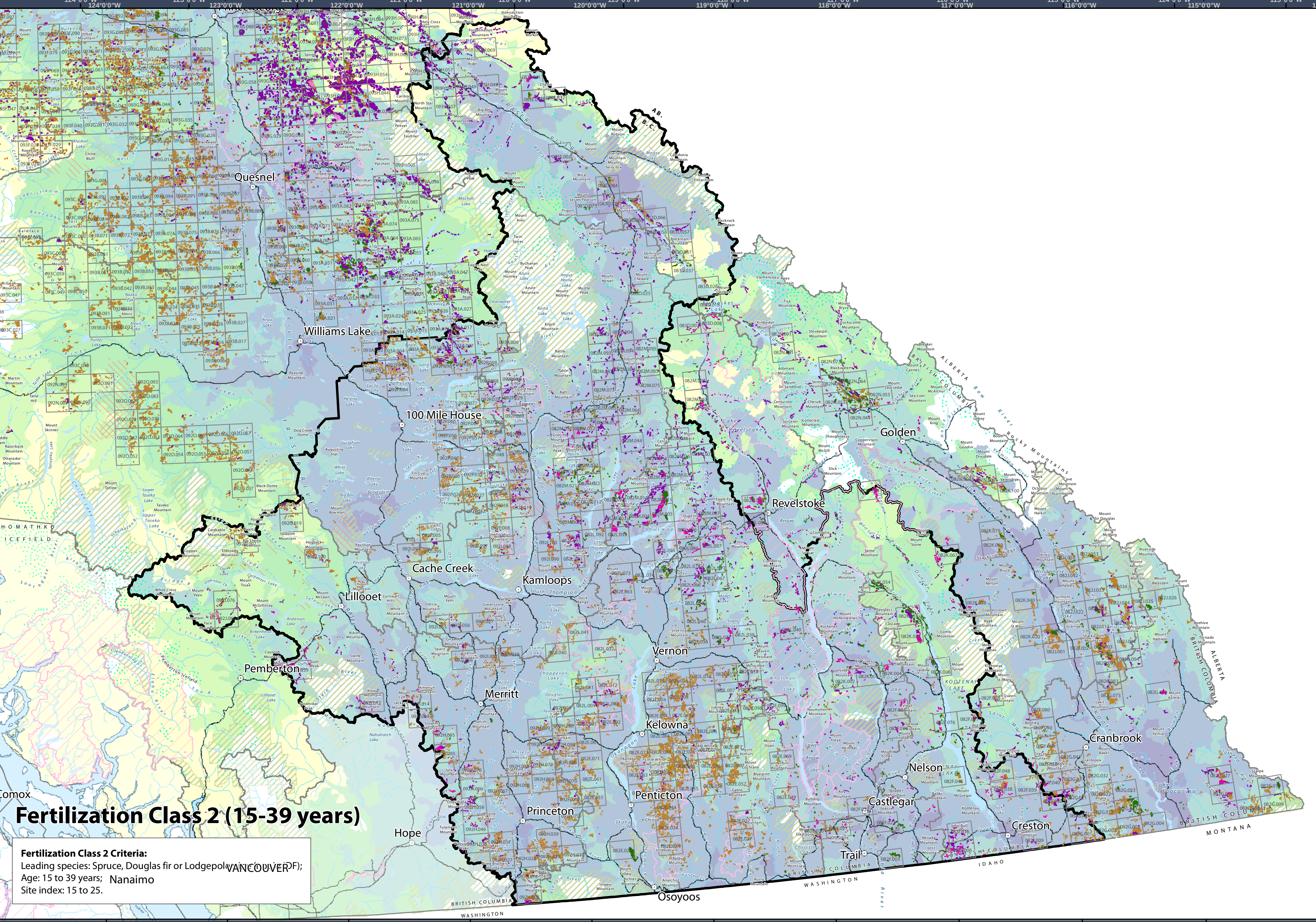
Fertilization Class 1 (40-80 years)

Fertilization Class 1 Criteria:
Leading species: Spruce or Douglas fir (not in ID)
Age: 40 to 80 years; Nanaimo
Site index: 15 to 25.



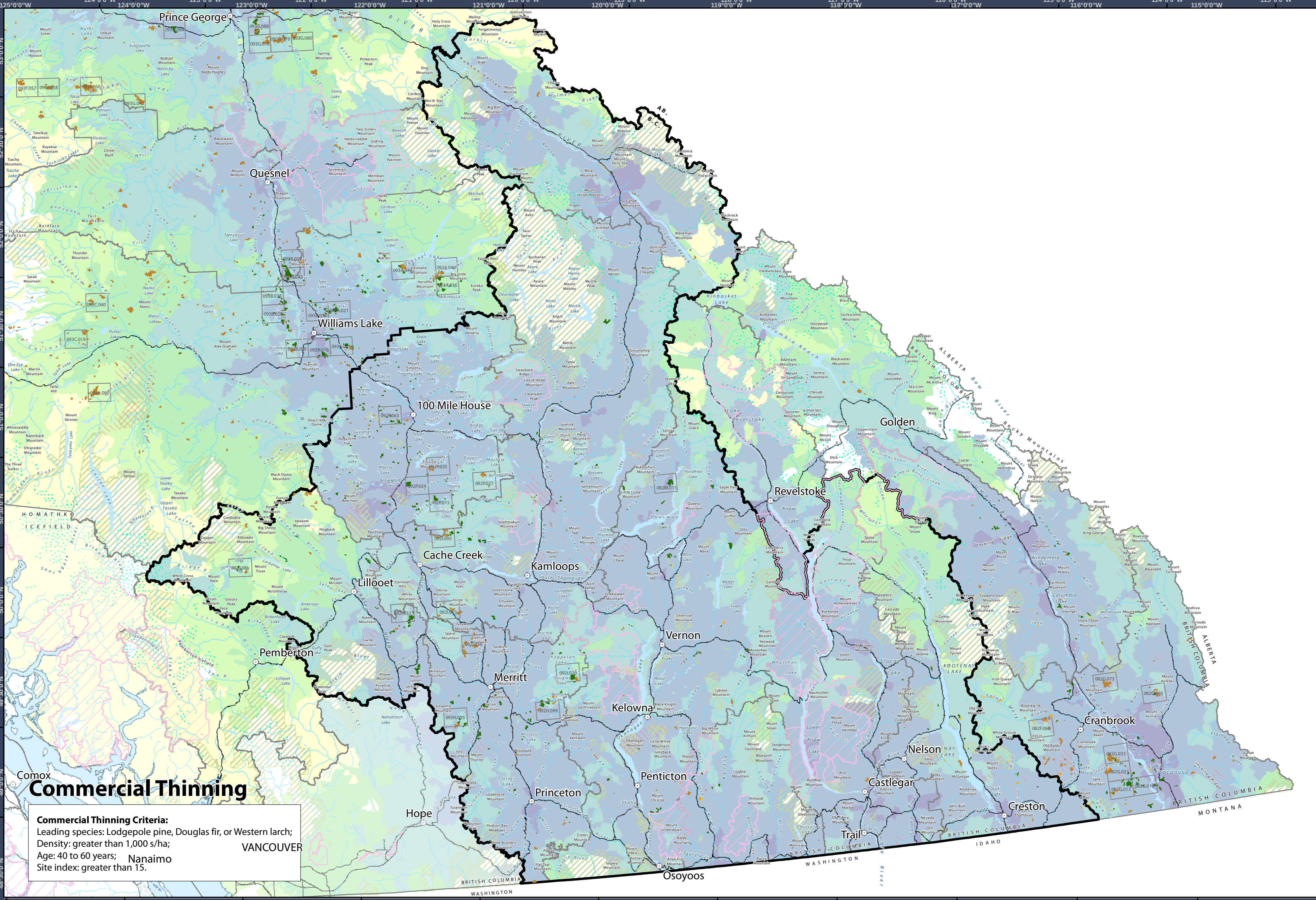
Spacing

Spacing Criteria:
Leading species: Lodgepole pine (density greater than 5,000 s/ha); or
White spruce, Spruce hybrid, Douglas fir, Western red cedar, or Western hemlock (density greater than 2,500 s/ha); or
White pine, Ponderosa pine, or Western larch (density greater than 1,500 s/ha);
Site index: greater than 15;
Height: greater than 2m; Nanaimo



Fertilization Class 2 (15-39 years)

Fertilization Class 2 Criteria:
Leading species: Spruce, Douglas fir or Lodgepole
Age: 15 to 39 years; Nanaimo
Site index: 15 to 25.



Commercial Thinning

Commercial Thinning Criteria:
Leading species: Lodgepole pine, Douglas fir, or Western larch;
Density: greater than 1,000 s/ha;
Age: 40 to 60 years; Nanaimo
Site index: greater than 15.

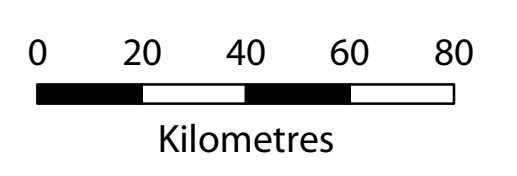
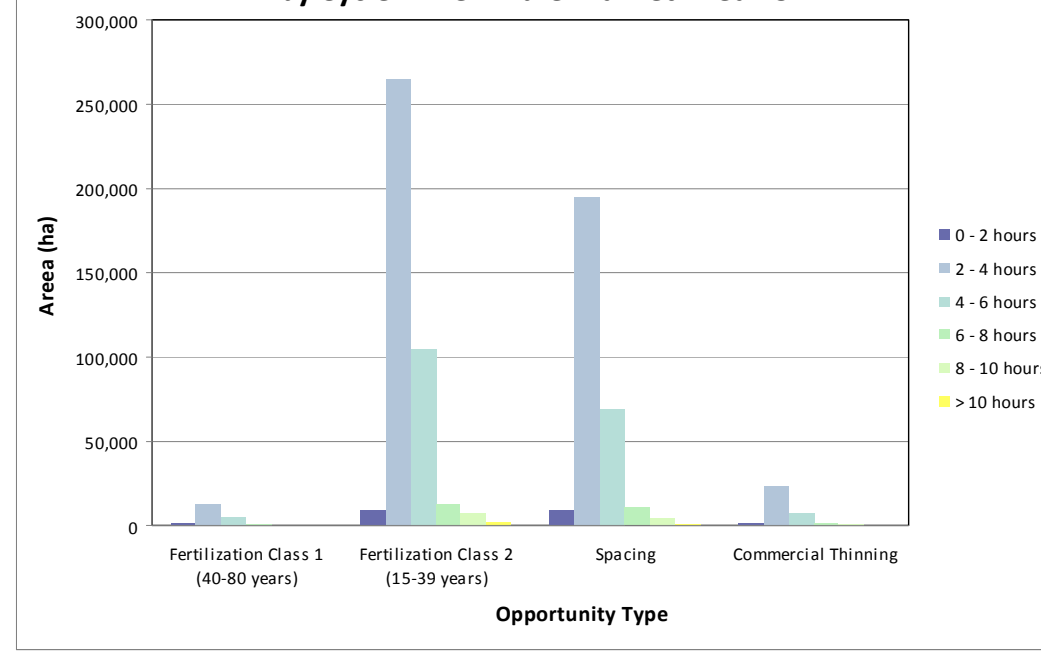
