

The Ministry of Children and Family Development (MCFD) provides basic audiology equipment and supplies to address an eligible child or youth's hearing loss. Cochlear implant supplies may be available to children and youth who have received cochlear implantation and are eligible for At Home Program Medical Benefits.

Cochlear implant supplies are provided up to a maximum of \$3,000 per 4 year period.

Requests for cochlear implant supplies must be submitted by a representative from the Cochlear Implant Program, BC Children's Hospital, on a [Request for Audiology Benefits](#) form.
