THIS AGREEMENT is made effective the 26 day of 6, 2010

(the "Licensee")

WHEREAS:

- A. Pursuant to the provisions of the *Forest Act*, the Licensor and Licensee entered into a replacement agreement for Tree Farm Licence 44, dated August 1, 2009,
- B. The Licensee has provided consent, dated July 16, 2010, to delete the area identified on the attached map from Tree Farm Licence 44,

THEREFORE:

- 1. In accordance with Section 39.1(1) of the *Forest Act*, the Licensor, with the consent of the Licensee, hereby changes the boundary and area of Tree Farm Licence 44 by removing the area, outlined in red on the attached map, from Tree Farm Licence 44 as of the effective date of this instrument.
- 2. For the purpose of Section 10 (1) of the Allowable Annual Cut Administration Regulation, the AAC associated with the area deleted under '1' above is 69,883 m³.
- 3. Paragraph 2.01 of Tree Farm License 44 is deleted and replaced with the following:
 - 2.01 Each year during the term of this Licence:
 - (a) 0 m³ of the allowable annual cut, from the types of timber specified under Paragraph 1.02(a), may be disposed of by the Timber Sales Manager within areas agreed to under Paragraph 3.01 or specified under Paragraph 3.02;
 - (b) 17,518 m³ of the allowable annual cut may be disposed of pursuant to Section 47.8 of the *Forest Act*.
