"Commencing at a point 13 chains South of the Northwest corner of T.L. 8474, Range Five Coast District; thence West 21 chains; thence North 22 chains; thence South 60° East 25 chains; thence South 10 chains to the point of commencement, containing 34 acres, more or less."

and the lands so withdrawn are and shall be henceforth no longer subject to or form any part of the said Tree Farm Licence Number 41 during the term of the licence of occupation issued in respect of the aforementioned lands.


