

## Vital Statistics Information Box

### MARRIAGES BY OTHER NON CHRISTIAN DENOMINATIONS

BRITISH COLUMBIA, 2004

**Table 49, Religious Representatives on Register and Marriages Performed by Religious Denomination, uses religious denomination categories from Statistics Canada. In 2004, a total of 1,022 marriages in British Columbia were solemnized by Other Non Christian Religion representatives. The table below provides additional details about these marriages.**

## *Summary*

---

Statistics arising from marriages are presented in this section. Unlike the birth and death statistics, which are based on usual residence, the marriage information is based on all marriages that occurred in British Columbia and includes non-residents. The tables in this section contain information about marriages by previous marital status, age of bride and groom, and type of ceremony.

Summary statistics for marriages in 2004 are presented below:

- A total of 22,073 marriages were solemnized in the province in 2004.
- In 2004, 62.3% of couples were marrying for the first time (13,746). In 19.7% of the marriages it was the first marriage for only one of the parties (4,359), and 18.0% involved couples where both partners were previously divorced or widowed (3,967).
- In 2004 there were 441 marriages where at least one party was under 20 years of age. These teen marriages accounted for one out of 50 marriages (2.0%). There were only 56 marriages (0.3%) where both parties were teenagers.
- There were 1,147 marriages in 2004 where at least one party was 60 years of age or older. These marriages accounted for one in 20 marriages (5.2%). There were 463 marriages (2.1%) where both parties were aged 60 or older.
- In 2004 almost two fifths (39.2%) of the marriages were performed by religious representatives (8,646) and three fifths (60.8%) were civil ceremonies (13,427).
- In B.C. in 2004 there were 21,009 marriages involving parties of the opposite sex and 1,064 marriages involving parties of the same sex.

#### HIGHLIGHTS TO TABLE 48

- In 2004 there were 441 marriages where at least one party was under 20 years of age. These teen marriages accounted for one out of 50 marriages (2.0%). There were only 56 marriages (0.3%) where both parties were teenagers.
- There were 15,146 marriages where at least one party was 25-39 years old. These marriages accounted for more than two-thirds (68.6%) of all marriages in 2004.
- There were 1,147 marriages in 2004 where at least one party was 60 years of age or older. These marriages accounted for one in 20 marriages (5.2%). There were 463 marriages (2.1%) where both parties were aged 60 or older.

#### HIGHLIGHTS TO TABLE 49/TABLE 50

- In British Columbia, Religious Representatives or Marriage Commissioners perform marriage ceremonies. There were 3,007 Religious Representatives and 472 Marriage Commissioners who solemnized marriages in the province in 2004.
- In 2004 almost two fifths (39.2%) of the marriages were performed by religious representatives (8,646) and three fifths (60.8%) were civil ceremonies (13,427).
