Your AFPS is due 23 February 2024 for:

All B.C. fish receivers are required to provide the Ministry of Agriculture & Food with a report on their seafood production under the *Fish and Seafood Act*. Data from all receivers, processors, vendors, and seafood marketers are combined and used for:

- Economic analyses
- Program and policy development
- Sector funding decisions
- International fisheries treaty negotiations

Submit your 2023 AFPS by 23 February! You must complete an AFPS for <u>each operation location</u>. Report all B.C. seafood sold or remaining in inventory in its final form.



This year, we have a new improved <u>web form</u> version of the AFPS that we ask you to fill out. Before doing so, you will need to obtain a <u>Basic</u> BCeID, if you do not already have one. You can do this by following these <u>instructions</u>, which only takes a few minutes. Refer to the <u>Guide</u> for instructions and tips on completing this AFPS.
