minerals in the lands described in Order-in-Council 413, approved the 6th day of March, 1950, be cancelled;

section (5) of section 14 of the "Mineral Act", chapter 213 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1948, a reservation be placed upon all minerals in the following described lands in the Onileca and Skeena Mining Divisions, namely:-

All and singular those lands and premises of all that area in the Mechako River, Iuchu Lake, Tetcachuck River, Ootsa Lake, Butsuk Lake, Netaikoo Lake, Intets Lake, Tetcachuck River, and Skins Lake drainage basins, including all connecting and tributary streams and lakes lying upstream from a line drawn northwest (the outlet of Cutoff Creek and below an elevation of 2,817 feet) excepting therout that part of the valley of the stream draining Raipp Lake beyond one mile from Cheslatta Lake;

Lands; namely, all that area in the Nanika River, Kidprice Lake, and upon all minerals in the following described streams and lakes lying upstream from a line drawn east and west across an elevation of 3,200 feet:

Lands; namely, an area eight miles wide (between Nanika Lake and upon all minerals in the following described lake) lying to the northeast of a straight line drawn from the west end of a small lake (immediately to the west of the west end of Tantsa Lake);

And upon all minerals in the following described of a straight line drawn from the head of Tantsa Lake to the junction one and a half miles on either side of the centre line of the Kenano River to its mouth; thence three miles wide being on either side of a straight line drawn from the said mouth of the Kenano River west for two miles;

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described lands; namely, an area one mile wide along the northwesterly and eastern shores of Berry Reach, Europa Reach, Alan Reach, Devastation Channel, Douglas Channel and Kitimat Arm to the head of said Kitimat Arm, including one mile southeasterly from Cormwall Point between Berry Reach and Europa Reach:

And upon all minerals in the following described lands; namely, an area one mile wide lying westerly from the centre line of the Komeno River from the junction of Noratzky Creek upstream for nine miles; thence an area two miles wide, being one mile on either side of a line drawn from the said point to a fork on Kildala River, approximately twelve miles from its mouth, thence two miles wide, being one mile to the south and one mile to the north of the centre line of the Kildala River for five miles; thence one mile wide being one mile north from the centre line of Kildala River and north shore of Kildala Arm; thence two miles wide, being one-half mile to the northeast and one and a half miles to the southwest of a line drawn from the mouth of the Dala River to the mouth of the Kitimat River;

And that the undersigned Minister of Mines do sign an order to that effect.
