- Read the rules on amendments outlined in Policy Guideline 23: Amending an Application for Dispute Resolution available on the Residential Tenancy Branch website.
- This paper form may be submitted through the Dispute Access site, or in person at a Service BC Centre that accepts RTB forms or the Burnaby Residential Tenancy Branch office.
- Important You must separate the request for amendment from your evidence or it may not be considered. To upload this form to the Dispute Access site, select the option "I want to submit a paper request for amendment".
- This form must be served to all respondents as soon as possible and no later than 14 calendar days prior to your hearing.

Important information about your application:

- This form is used to add or remove an applicant, remove a respondent, add a related claim or change an existing claim. An amendment may not be used to add another respondent. The applicant can make this request during the hearing.
- Use form #RTB42-T (tenants) or #RTB42-L (landlord) if you would like to add a related claim or alter an existing claim.
- This form cannot be used to amend an Application by Direct Request.
