

OVERVIEW

The Driftwood FSR provides essential access to local communities, First Nations and industrial users. The road will be realigned between 57.8km and 60.2km as a part of the ongoing upgrades to improve access and user safety. The road has been relocated protect the environment and improve the existing crossing. The old bridge at 59.7km will be replaced by a new double lane 21m concrete composite bridge and another smaller bridge installed at approximately 600m along the new re-alignment. The realignment will maintain natural drainage patterns in the area.
